SPAIN'S SUBTROPICAL "FORTUNATE ISLES": THE CANARY ISLANDS

12 days, Thursday, January 17, to Monday, January 28, 2019

A wonderful winter break on an archipelago blessed with a subtropical and dry climate, outstanding natural beauty, including exuberant vegetation as well as superb coastal, mountain, and desert landscapes, a rich history and culture, and excellent Spanish food and wine! We stay in a fine 4-star/first-class hotel on the island of Tenerife, but will explore another island, historic Gomera on a daytrip by fast ferry. Daily breakfast and buffet dinner, including wine! The tour is escorted by Jacques Pauwels, PhD, author of Beneath the Dust of Time (London, 2009), who will lecture on the history of the islands, their aboriginal inhabitants, the Guanches, and the role of the Canaries in the voyages of discoverers like Columbus.

Tour cost, based on double occupancy, from Toronto: \$3,475 – "land only": \$2,425 Single room supplement (limited availability!): only \$345

PROPOSED ITINERARY:

<u>Day 1 – Thursday, January 17</u>: Evening departure from Toronto International Airport to Madrid on a nonstop flight with Air Canada. Dinner and a light breakfast will be served on board.

<u>Day 2 – Friday, January 18</u>: Mid-morning arrival in Madrid, and connecting flight to Tenerife, described by Wikitravel as "probably one of the last European paradise isles, offering lush forests, exotic fauna and flora, deserts, mountains, volcanoes, incredibly beautiful coastlines and spectacular beaches." Arrival in early afternoon, and immediate transfer to our four-star/first-class Hotel Tenerife Playa, magnificently located on the waterfront in the resort of **Puerto de La Cruz**, in the middle of the "banana belt" of the lush northern shore of the island (www.h10hotels.com/Tenerife-Playa). Free time to settle in, followed by our first buffet-dinner in the restaurant of the hotel.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE PROVIDE STANDARD ROOMS *WITHOUT SEA VIEW*. ROOMS *WITH SEA VIEW* ARE AVAILABLE AT A SURCHARGE OF \$190 *PER PERSON* FOR THE ENTIRE 9-DAY STAY.

<u>Day 3 - Saturday, January 19</u>: Morning walking tour of Puerto de la Cruz. Frequent stops will be made at lookout points along the seafront promenade to view and photograph the rugged rocky coast and the snow-capped Pico del Teide, a huge volcano, with 3,718 m the highest point in the archipelago and indeed in all of Spain. Local attractions include Martianez Lake, a post-modern complex of swimming pools surrounded by vegetation and volcanic rock; Playa Jardin, "Garden Beach," a black sandy beach; the quaint old town and port with 17th- and 18th-century houses; historic San Telmo Chapel; and Castillo San Felipe Fortress. The afternoon is free to explore the town on your own, shop, or visit one of its museums, such as the Archaeological Museum or the Museum of Contemporary Art.

<u>Day 4 - Sunday, January 20</u>: Full-day circle tour of Tenerife, the largest of the seven Canary Islands, featuring a very green northern part (with countless banana plantations) and an arid southern zone, separated by Teide, a huge volcano. Our itinerary will include the quaint town of **Icod de Los Vinos**, famous for its particularly impressive (and very old) specimen of the dragon tree, the only survivor of the archipelago's original flora; the Castillo de San Miguel in **Garachico**; the resort of **Los Gigantes**, whose name refers to enormous black cliffs with a vertical drop of over 400 meters; and **Candelaria**, a famous centre of pilgrimage devoted to the Virgin Mary. Return to the hotel in time for dinner.

<u>Day 5 - Monday, January 21:</u> Free day. An *optional* full-day excursion (by fast ferry) will be offered to **Gran Canaria**, second largest island of the archipelago. This would include visits to the local cathedral and the Basílica of the Virgen del Pino in Las Nieves (Agaete), a scenic drive via Valleseco to Cruz de Tejera to visit the typical shops and enjoy the panoramic view, and, if time permits, a tour of the

spectacular Dunes of Maspalomas, similar to the Sahara, and some time in Las Palmas, the island's capital.

<u>Day 6 - Tuesday, January 22:</u> Full-day excursion to Tenerife's historically most important towns: **Santa Cruz**, the capital, and **La laguna**, a university city, with visits to the most important churches and monasteries as well as free time for shopping.

WEATHER:

Like the other islands of the Canaries Archipelago, Tenerife enjoys a wonderful subtropical climate, with lots of sunshine and very little rain. In late January, the temperature oscillates between a low of 16-17° C and a high of 21° C, with a daily mean temperature of 18° C.

<u>Day 7 - Wednesday, January 23:</u> Free day. An optional dolphin and whale watching boat tour will be available, including transportation to/from the port of Playa de las Americas, on the SW coast of Tenerife. The Atlantic waters between western Tenerife and the island of La Gomera are home to giant sperm, minke, white and blue whales as well as common, spotted, and bottlenose dolphins. This evening, *optional* Flamenco show!



Day 8 - Thursday, January 24: Full-day excursion (by ferry boat) to La Gomera, one of the smallest islands of the Canary group, situated 35 km south-west of Tenerife, a distance covered by fast ferry in about one hour. Our local sightseeing will include a drive through Garajonay National Park, a rare example of "laurisilva," the humid kind of subtropical forest that covered almost all of Europe in the Tertiary Era, a UNESCO World Heritage Site (https://whc.unesco.org/en/list/380), with stops at spectacular viewpoints and in quaint villages, a demonstration of traditional whistle-blowing, an

(https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PgEmSb0cKBg), lunch in a country restaurant, and time to explore the island's capital, San Sebastian, with its memories of Columbus, who, having arrived from Spain, took on supplies here before sailing on his 1492 voyage of discovery to the New World, propelled by the prevailing

northeast trade winds. (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/La_Gomera)

<u>Day 9 - Friday, January 25:</u> Morning excursion to **Teide National Park**, the most visited National Park in the Canary Islands and Spain; with around 3 million visitors annually, it is second only to Mt. Fuji in Japan! Teide was a sacred mountain to the aboriginal inhabitants of the Canary Islands, like Mt Olympus was http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Teide)

<u>Day 10 - Saturday, January 26:</u> Morning visit to **Loro Park**, a subtropical garden with an impressive collection of animals, including parrots, monkeys, penguins, dolphins, and crocodiles! Afternoon at leisure.

<u>Day 11 - Sunday, January 27:</u> Morning free, and group lunch, followed by transfer to the airport and flight to Madrid. Arrival at Madrid Airport, and transfer to a nearby 4-star hotel, the Sercotel or similar.

Circumstances permitting, it may be possible to enjoy some *optional* sightseeing and/or dinner in the Spanish capital.

<u>Day 12 - Monday, January 28:</u> After a leisurely breakfast, short transfer to the airport via hotel shuttle and non-stop return flight to Toronto, with Air Canada. Departure at 11:00AM, and arrival in Toronto at 1:30PM.

Tour cost, based on double occupancy, from Toronto: \$3,475 – "land only": \$2,425 Single room supplement (limited availability): only \$345 Upgrade to Seaview room: \$190.00 per person

THE CANARY ISLANDS

The Canary Islands are a Spanish archipelago situated in the Atlantic Ocean off the northwest coast of Africa, approximately 100 km west of southern Morocco. There are seven islands: Tenerife, Gran Canaria, Fuerteventura, Lanzarote, La Palma, La Gomera, and El Hierro, as well as a few islets. The archipelago's beaches, climate and important natural attractions, especially Mount Teide, the third largest volcano in the world, make it a major tourist destination, with over 12 million visitors per year. The islands enjoy a subtropical climate. During the times of the Spanish Empire, the Canaries were the main stopover for Spanish galleons on their way to the New World because of the favorable easterly trade winds. The name Islas Canarias is likely derived from the Latin term Insula Canaria, meaning "Island of the Dogs." These dogs were probably a species of monk seals, known as "sea dogs" in Latin, no longer present in the archipelago. The original inhabitants of the islands were the mysterious Guanches, now extinct. RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSITS:

REFUND OF UNUSED ARRANGEMENTS:

If cancellation occurs while the tour is in progress, no refund can be made for the tour portion not taken. CANCELLATION POLICY:

Refund of deposit is made if cancellation is received in writing by Pauwels Travel Bureau Ltd. more than 90 days prior of the departure date of the tour less a \$500.00 non-refundable administrative fee per person. For cancellation received in writing 90 days prior or less the following cancellation charges apply: 90 days to 61 days before departure: 25% of tour cost

We shall not be held responsible for the failure by any person or company to render any transportation, lodging or other travel service to be provided on the tour. All hotels, transportation and other travel services are provided subject to all the terms and conditions under which they are offered to the public generally.
- 2. I know that tour programs include walking, and may including hiking and fitness programs that have potential hazardous activities associated with them. I should not participate prior to approval by my physician. I assume any and all other risks associated with these events included but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather including high heat and/or humidity.
- 3. To release, indemnify and hold harmless Pauwels Travel Bureau and their affiliates (which term shall include parents, subsidiaries, officers, directors, shareholders, agents and employees of Pauwels Travel Bureau as well as Pauwels Travel themselves) (the "Released Parties") from, and agree not to sue the Released Parties for, any claims that I may have arising from, or in connection with, any personal injury, bodily injury, mental anguish, emotional distress, physical, property or other damage that I may suffer from any cause whatsoever related in any way to my participation in this tour. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, I release, indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from, and agree not to sue them for any personal injury, bodily injury, mental anguish, emotional distress, physical, property or other damage that I may suffer from the Released Parties' negligence other than from intentional or reckless acts by such parties. I further agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all acts of God, war (whether declared or undeclared), terrorist activities, incidents of politically motivated violence, illness or quarantine, strikes or government restrictions or the acts or omissions of any other agents over which the Released Parties have no direct control, including, without limitation, airlines, railways, bus companies, hotels,

shipping companies, guides and sub-contracted agents or tour operators. This release also includes activities not offered that may be considered risky. I further release any Tour Directors, bus drivers or other individuals involved in my tour.

- 4. That the air carrier's liability for loss of or damage to baggage or property, or for death or injury to person, is limited by their tariffs, or the Warsaw Convention, or both.
- 5. That Pauwels Travel Bureau shall have no liability or responsibility for me when I am absent from activities, such as visits to friends or relatives or during stay-ahead/stay-behind option periods if the stay-ahead/stay-behind period does not include the services of a Tour Director.
- 6. To abide by directions of my Tour Director or other leadership personnel during my tour. Failure to do so may result in my termination from tour immediately. I understand that if I abuse or disobey such laws, even unintentionally, I waive my right to a refund, and Pauwels Travel may send me home at my own expense. I also understand that should local authorities be involved, I will be subject to the laws of the country I am visiting.
- 8. That if I become ill or incapacitated, Pauwels Travel and its employees, or a designated chaperone may take any action they deem necessary for my safety and well-being, including securing medical treatment (at my own expense) and transporting me home. Pauwels Travel retains the right, in its sole discretion, to contact the traveller's parent(s) and/or guardian or emergency contact with regard to health issues or any matters whatsoever that relates to the traveller's tour. These rights transcend any and all privacy regulations that may apply. - 9. That Pauwels Travel may use any film likenesses taken of me and any of my comments while on a tour for future publication and also use my contact information for future Pauwels Travel communications.
