11 days, Thursday, September 20, to Sunday, September 30, 2018

PROPOSED ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Thursday, September 20:

Depart Toronto Pearson airport on Alitalia at 22:25 with dinner and a light breakfast served on board.

Day 2 - Friday, September 21:

Arrival in Rome at 13:00 with a connecting flight to Malta at 16:50 arriving in Valletta at 18:15. Meet and Greet your guide with private coach & transfer to the centrally-located 3-star hotel, check-in, and walk to a local restaurant for a welcome dinner.

Day 3 – Saturday, September 22:

After breakfast, walking tour of the fortified historical centre of Malta's capital, Valletta, classified in its entirety as a UNESCO World Heritage Site (http://whc.unesco.org/en/list/131); 11:00 AM we will enjoy "The Malta Experience" where you discover 7,000 years of history in a audio visual show, after which we cross the road & enjoy a fully guided tour of the La Sacra Infermia. Valletta will also be Europe's "cultural capital" in 2018(www.gov.mt/en/about%20malta/valletta/pages/european-capital-of-culture-in-2018.aspx). The old town is inextricably linked to the history of the Knights of St. John of Jerusalem, originally an order of "fighting monks," similar to the Knights Templar, established in the context of the Crusades. Built after the 1565 Great Siege of Malta, and named after Grand Master Jean Parisot de la Valette, Among the highlights of our visit will be St. John's Cathedral with its stunning baroque interior, decorated with paintings by artists such as Caravaggio and Flemish tapestries, and a crypt with tombs of Grand Masters, including La Valette; Republic Street, the main shopping street; the imposing walls and gates ramparts built by the Knights in the late 16th century, featured on UNESCO's tentative list of world heritage sites (*http://whc.unesco.org/en/tentativelists/982*); the 17th-century Manoel Theatre, a miniature version of Milan's La Scala: Following a break for lunch we then visit the National Library on Republic Square, where the archives of the Knights of St. John are kept; and the 'Holy

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Infirmary,' located beneath the Mediterranean Conference Centre with a capacity of over 600 beds a state-of-the-art hospital at the time of its establishment by the Order in 1574. Dinner tonight is on your own.

Day 4 - Sunday, September 23:

This morning we will have a full morning guided tour of the Grand Master's Palace. This building built in 1571 has always hosted the government in Malta, first the knights, then under the British it served as the Governor's Palace, and now it hosts the President's office as well as the House of Representatives.

The Grandmaster's Palace & the State Rooms are built around two courtyards. Inside is the famous Council Chamber and other rooms and passages which are all splendidly furnished. The Palace armoury is also located here and is well worth visiting. Following some free time for lunch you can carry on your visit of the Palace or Fort St. Elmo. Group dinner this evening in a local restaurant.

Day 5 - Monday, September 24: BIRGU "Maritime City of the Knights"

Following-breakfast we meet in the lobby of the hotel and make the short journey to the city gate to embark on

a full day walking tour of the original Collacchio; the historical centre of Birgu an area of narrow streets containing "The Inquisitors Palace and St Joseph's Oratory, Maritime Museum, Main Square & Fort Angelo. No group dinner this evening.

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Day 6 – Tuesday, September 25:

Morning excursion to Malta's picturesque "Old City," located high on a ridge in the island's interior, known to the Romans as Melita and later divided into two parts, Mdina and Rabat; this was the island's capital before the Order arrived and decided to settle on the coast. Mdina/Rabat boasts ancient city walls and gates, fine residences of aristocratic families, as well as churches and catacombs, associated with the arrival here in 60AD of St. Paul, who reportedly converted the Roman governor to Christianity. This afternoon you can visit Ta'Qali market and roadside stands before returning to Valletta via the coastal resorts of Sliema and St. Julian's. Final dinner in Malta at a local restaurant.

Day 7 - Wednesday, September 26:

Free morning in Valetta for some last minute shopping and sightseeing before transferring to the airport for your short flight to Rome where on arrival you will meet your private coach and transferred to your centrally located hotel. Brief orientation tour of the local area. Dinner on your own.

Day 8 - Thursday, September 27:

This morning we focus on Vatican City, with thorough visits to St. Peter's Basilica with its huge central altar, papal crypt, treasury, massive dome and Michelangelo's evocative Pietà, as well as the Vatican Museum, featuring frescoes by Raphael, paintings by Giotto, and antiquities such as the celebrated Hellenistic sculpture, Laocoön. But the absolute highlight will of course be the Sistine Chapel, venue of the papal elections, with Michelangelo's superb paintings. In the afternoon, leisurely exploration (on foot) of the picturesque district around Piazza Navona and the Pantheon. No group dinner this evening, and there may be an opportunity to attend a classical music concert (optional).



Day 9 - Friday, September 28:

Morning exploration of "Imperial Rome," featuring the still very impressive ruins dating back to the time of the Roman Empire and rulers such as Caesar, Augustus, Nero, and Trajan. Highlights will include the Colosseum, the Imperial Forums and the Roman Forum (flanked by the over-the-top Monument to King Victor Emmanuel, known as the "Wedding Cake"!), the Circus Maximus, the triumphal arches of Constantine and Titus, and Trajan's Column. In the afternoon, leisurely walking tour to the Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps.

<u>Day 10 - Saturday, September 29:</u> Following breakfast in the hotel the day is free for you to explore Rome. Farewell group dinner this evening in a local restaurant. (B,D)

- 2. I know that tour programs include walking and may including hiking and fitness programs that have potential hazardous activities associated with them. I should not participate prior to approval by my physician. I assume

any and all other risks associated with these events included but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather including high heat and/or humidity.

- To release, indemnify and hold harmless Pauwels Travel Bureau and their affiliates (which term shall include 3. parents, subsidiaries, officers, directors, shareholders, agents and employees of Pauwels Travel Bureau as well as Pauwels Travel themselves) (the "Released Parties") from, and agree not to sue the Released Parties for, any claims that I may have arising from, or in connection with, any personal injury, bodily injury, mental anguish, emotional distress, physical, property or other damage that I may suffer from any cause whatsoever related in any way to my participation in this tour.
